

Correction

Re: “**Bilateral acute angle closure caused by supraciliary effusions associated with venlafaxine intake**” by de Guzman MHP, Thiagalingam S, Ong PY and Goldberg I in the 7 February 2005 issue of the Journal (*Med J Aust* 2005; 182: 121-123). In the second paragraph of the “Clinical record”, the number “3” appears, instead of a multiplication symbol, in two places. The second sentence should read “Spectacle correction revealed compound hypermetropic astigmatism (right eye, +1.00 + 1.50 75°; left eye, +1.75 + 2.25 110°).” In the same article, the initial capital letter (“V”) of the first paragraph after the clinical record box is missing: the first word should be “Venlafaxine”.

Similarly, in the article by Ng CVT [*page 120*] in the same issue, the initial capital letter (“M”) is missing: the first word of the first paragraph should be “Myasthenia”. □
