During the production process, the drug name “timentin” was inadvertently changed to “timolol”.

The sentence describing antibiotic therapy should read: “On Day 14, ceftriaxone and gentamicin were changed to empirical clavulanate/ticarcillin (Timentin, GlaxoSmithKline, Australia) and ciprofloxacin because of persistent fever and rising WCC.”
