Appendix 1: Regulatory Models for Surrogacy in Australia¹

| Model | Jurisdictions | Details |
|--------------------------------|------------------------|--|
| No surrogacy regulation | Northern Territory | No laws to allow intending parents access to legal parentage. |
| Moderate regulation | Qld, NSW, ACT, Tas, SA | Written agreement required, intending parent & surrogate must have counselling and legal advice prior to commencing. Parentage orders available post birth. |
| High regulation | Vic, WA | Pre-approval from State regulator required prior to treatment, Vic requires criminal history and child protection history checks Written agreement required, intended parent & surrogate must have counselling and legal advice prior to commencing Parentage order required post birth. |
