Appendix 1: Regulatory Models for Surrogacy in Australia 1

Model	Jurisdictions	Details
No surrogacy regulation	Northern Territory	No laws to allow intending parents access to legal parentage.
Moderate regulation	Qld, NSW, ACT, Tas, SA	Written agreement required, intending parent & surrogate must have counselling and legal advice prior to commencing. Parentage orders available post birth.
High regulation	Vic, WA	Pre-approval from State regulator required prior to treatment, Vic requires criminal history and child protection history checks Written agreement required, intended parent & surrogate must have counselling and legal advice prior to commencing Parentage order required post birth.
