

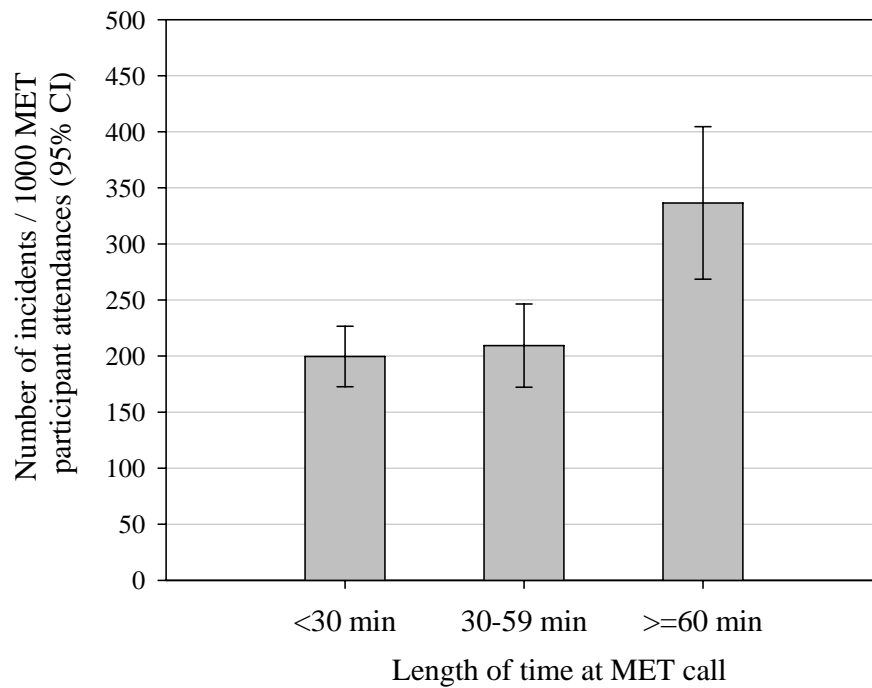

Appendix 3 – Incident rate reported as a result of staff leaving normal duties to attend Medical Emergency Team (MET) calls, by time spent at MET call



I-bars indicate 95% confidence intervals. There were significant differences in the proportions of incidents when comparing <30 min and 30-59 min to >=60 min (both $p < 0.001$) using the Pearson Chi-Square test, but no difference when comparing <30 min to 30-59 min ($p = 0.65$).
